Purpose: Support our member churches in their mission outreach through prayer, education, financial grants, and increasing awareness of the importance of missions and evangelism.

- Bathe all of our mission outreach in prayer
- Support the growth of the summer camp program
- Strategize and support church planting within our region
- Encourage and support short-term mission trips and disaster relief trips
- Support missionaries whose home churches are member churches
- Assist in meeting local needs in member churches where the church is not able to meet this need on their own
- Encourage evangelistic work in our member churches and provide resources for evangelical training
- Encourage congregational support of international missions, especially to those areas that are unreached for Christ, with an emphasis on using indigenous missionaries
- Develop contact lists for member churches of Witness Committee chairpersons and individuals that have a special interest in missions. Find several more members for the Missions team.
- Foster a missional emphasis by sending bulletin notes and articles for congregational newsletters
- Support and pray for National CBC missionaries; be a channel to help member churches understand their work and their mission field

Sharing Hope in Jesus' Name Conference

This conference was an inspirational and informational time for anyone who volunteers with *Samaritan's Purse*. It included updates on the organization, preaching, teaching, worship, and fellowship. We learned that The Billy Graham Evangelical Association and Samaritan's Purse both send out volunteers for disaster relief in the United States and overseas. These teams work together to meet physical needs and spiritual/emotional needs of people who are in crises. Usually, the crisis is due to an event like a hurricane, flood, or tornado; but teams are also serving in other countries such as Ukraine and Turkey. Our denomination, *Covenant Brethren Church*, has chosen to partner with Samaritan's Purse for the purpose of disaster relief with evangelism. Anyone can volunteer to serve and no training is necessary. Fourteen and fifteen-year olds can volunteer along with their parents, and sixteen and seventeen-year olds need to bring adult supervision. Many of the people at this conference were retired and volunteer over and over again! *A place can be found for anyone to work - no matter what one's abilities or limitations may be.*

We were most impressed by the love this organization shows to all people. The volunteers who help clear rubble and rebuild houses also share the Good News of the Gospel, providing comfort and spiritual encouragement. We heard many testimonies of the amazing ways that the Holy Spirit used volunteers to meet the needs of disaster victims.


Summer Camp Shenandoah Meadows


